This camp runs parallel to the National Team's preparation to compete at the International Biology Olympiad, so you will have the opportunity to work with the team headed to the IBO, and see what it takes for you to be on the team next year!



The CBO/OCB wants to inspire you with opportunities not normally found in high school labs, which challenge and stimulate students to expand their talents and to promote their career as scientists.

General information:

Location: University of Toronto Schools (UTS)

Dates: Sunday, July 8 (9-10 am; drop-off) — Thursday, July 12, 2018 (3-4 pm; pickup)

Daily Itinerary:

Breakfast, Morning Labs, Lunch, Afternoon lab, Dinner, and evening lecture, presentation and/or research time and other fun activities, and some free time! The labs and activities will cover many areas of biology such as cell biology; biochemistry; plants biology; animal physiology; systematics; microbiology; molecular biology; etc.

Cost: \$750.00 (NOTE: \$200 non-refundable deposit due at registration and \$550 due at the beginning of the camp; make cheques payable to Canadian Biology Olympiad).

Cost includes: Lab materials and staff, meals (from Lunch July 8th to Lunch July 12th), and accommodation in Residences which includes 24-hour adult supervision.

*NOTE: Transfers to/from Pearson International Airport, or A/GO station can be arranged for additional cost. Please include the information in the registration form if you require this option. If you plan for arrival on Saturday, July 7, 2018, please note there will be an additional cost of \$100.00 for accommodation, meals and pick-up from the airport or train station.
